This care system is aimed at strengthening the provider-patient relationship by replacing visit-by-visit care based on illnesses and patient health concerns with coordinated care and a long-term healing relationship.

The objective is to have one place to facilitate partnerships between individual patients, their personal providers, and when appropriate, the patient's family. Care is facilitated by Care Coordinators, through technology, and shared decision making to assure that patients get the most comprehensive care for their conditions.

PCMH is:

Person-Centered: supports patients and families in managing decisions and care plans.

Coordinated: care is organized by a personal Care Coordinator.

Committed to Quality and Safety: maximizes use of health technology, decision support and other tools.

Comprehensive: whole person care provided by a team.
